NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that bids are being solicited by The Christian Valley Park Community Services District (the "District") to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, tools, tax, and services necessary for the **CHRISTAIN VALLEY PARK WATER TREATMENT PLANT EMERGENCY GENERATOR (the "Work")**.

Bids must be received by the District on by **June 22, 2022 at 9:00am**. **Bid opening will be at the site located at 5174 Westridge Circle, Auburn, CA.**

Any bids received via mail at the address above will be opened publicly at the bid opening location and time listed above. Contractor is responsible for ensuring bid package is received by the District in time for the opening on the bid date. The District will check the mail at 8:00 am the morning of the bid date. Sealed bids received by mail will be opened at the bid opening at the site at 9:00am. Any bid packages received later than 8:00am on or after June 22, 2022 at the post office will be rejected. Any bid packages received later than 9:00am on or after June 22, 2022 at the project site will be rejected.

Bids received by mail will be opened at the formal bid opening at the time and location listed above.

NTC-1. Description of Work: The Work consists generally of the following: Remove and relocate existing 80WK generator and transfer switch. Existing equipment shall be relocated to the California Conservation Corp facility located at 3710 Christian Valley Road, Auburn CA. Contractor shall provide equipment to safely load/unload equipment. Furnish and install liquid propane generator including conduit and conductors. Modifications to existing conduit and fuel lines/regulators as necessary to accommodate new unit. Existing underground conduit and generator pad can be reused.

The District has estimated cost of the Work to be **Thirty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$36,000.00)**.

Email: glabudde@hydros-engineering.com. Contractors must receive Contract Documents from Hydros Engineering to be officially included on the Plan Holders List. Only contractors included on the Plan Holders List will be eligible to submit a bid. Addenda will be sent to contractors on the Plan Holders List.

ARTICLE 1 - BID RECIPIENT

- 1.1 This Bid is submitted to:
Christian Valley Park CSD, PO Box 6857, Auburn CA 95604
- 1.2 The undersigned Bidder proposes and agrees, if this Bid is accepted, to enter into an Agreement with Owner in the form included in the Bidding Documents to perform all Work as specified or indicated in the Bidding Documents for the prices and within the times indicated in this Bid and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.

ARTICLE 2 – BIDDER’S ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

- 2.01 Bidder accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Instructions to Bidders, including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of Bid security. This Bid will remain subject to acceptance for 60 days after the Bid opening, or for such longer period of time that Bidder may agree to in writing upon request of Owner.

ARTICLE 3 - BIDDER’S REPRESENTATIONS

- 3.1 In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents that:
 - A. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, and any data and reference items identified in the Bidding Documents, and hereby acknowledges receipt of the following Addenda:

- B. Bidder has visited the Site, conducted a thorough, alert visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with and satisfied itself as to the general, local and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- C. Bidder is familiar with and has satisfied itself as to all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress and performance of the Work, including all American Iron and Steel Requirements.
- D. Bidder has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings, and (2) reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
- E. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and any Site-related reports and drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, with respect to the

effect of such information, observations, and documents on (1) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (2) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder; and (3) Bidder's safety precautions and programs.

- F. Bidder agrees, based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of the Work at the price bid and within the times required, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.
- G. Bidder is aware of the general nature of the Work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- H. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and confirms that the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Bidder.
- I. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance and furnishing of the Work.
- J. The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that Bidder has complied with every requirement of this Article, and that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.

ARTICLE 4 - BIDDER'S CERTIFICATION

4.1 Bidder certifies that:

- A. This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any collusive agreement or rules of any group, association, organization or corporation;
- B. Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid;
- C. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding; and
- D. Bidder has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 4.01.D:
 - 1. "corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of any thing of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process.
 - 2. "fraudulent practice" means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made to (a) to influence the bidding process to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition;
 - 3. "collusive practice" means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels; and
 - 4. "coercive practice" means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the execution of the Contract.




