Christian Valley Park Community Service District will receive sealed proposals for road/ditch preparation and chip/seal work in Christian Valley until 7:00pm, Tuesday, September 13, 2022. At that time the proposals will be publicly opened and read at the California Conservation Corps (California Conservation Corps Office) located at the end of Christian Valley Road - 3710 Christian Valley Road, Auburn, CA 95604.

PLEASE USE PREVAILING WAGES IN THE SUBMITTED BID TO THE DISTRICT.

PLEASE STRATEGICALLY PLACE TEMPORARY SIGNS NOTIFYING DRIVERS OF LOOSE GRAVEL OR UNSAFE ROAD CONDITIONS.

Project No. 21-01: Prepare roads and ditches, and apply chip/seal, as specified in the Special Provisions and Plans.

Bid Bonds will not be required for this project. The successful bidder shall furnish a Payment Bond and a Performance Bond in the amount of 100% of the costs of the work.

For your convenience, sealed proposals can be either mailed to Christian Valley Park Community Service District, P.O. SPECIAL PROVISIONS

CHRISTIAN VALLEY PARK COMMUNITY SERVICE DISTRICT ROAD WORK

The work embraced herein shall be done in accordance with the Placer County General Specifications dated October 1996, insofar as the same may apply and in accordance with the following Special Provisions.

In the case of conflict between the General Specifications and these Special Provisions, the Special Provisions shall take precedence over and be used in lieu of such conflicting portions.

Section 1 Definitions and Terms shall conform to provisions of Section 1 of the General Specifications.

1-1.00 Standard Specifications

1-1.13 Reference to the County or County of Placer, State or State of California, Department of Public Works shall mean Christian Valley Park Community Service District, herein referred to as CVPCSD.

1-1.5 Reference to Board of Supervisors, Director, Engineer, shall mean Board of Directors, CVPCSD.

Section 2 Proposal Conditions shall conform to the provision of Section 2 of the General Specifications.

Section 3 Award and Execution of Contract shall conform to provisions of Section 3 of the General Specifications and these Special Provisions.

3-1.01 Award of Contract - The right is reserved to reject any and all proposals.

The award of the contract, if it be awarded, will be to the lowest responsible bidder whose proposal complies with all the requirements prescribed. Such Award, if made, will be made within thirty (30) days after the opening of the proposals. If the lowest responsible bidder refuses or fails to execute the contract, the Board of Directors may award the Contract to the second lowest responsible bidder.

Such award, if made, will be made within sixty (60) days after the opening of proposals. The period of time specified above within which the Award of Contract may be made shall be subject to extension for such further period as may be agreed upon in writing between the Board of Directors and the bidder concerned.

- Section 4 Scope of Work shall conform to the provisions of Section 4 of the General Specifications.
- Section 5 Control of Work shall conform to the provision of Section 5 of the General Specifications.
- Section 6 Control of Materials shall conform to the provisions of Section 6 of the General Specifications and these Special Provisions.
- Section 7 Legal Relations and Responsibility shall conform to the requirements of Section 7 of the General Specifications and these Special Provisions.

7-1.095 Flagging Costs
In lieu of the conflicting provisions of Section 7-1.095, all flagging costs shall be included in the various items of work and no additional compensation will be allowed.

7-1.12A Insurance Worker's Compensation
Contractor shall maintain adequate Worker's Compensation Insurance under the law of the State of California, and shall provide, where practicable, Employer's General Liability Insurance for the benefit of his employees and The employees of any subcontractor under him not protected by such compensation laws. Proof of such insurance satisfactory to the governing body shall be given by filing certificates of such insurance with the governing body, in form satisfactory to said governing body.

The policy shall not be canceled or reduced in coverage until after thirty (30) Days written notice. Wording to this effect shall appear on the face of the certificate.

In the event the policy is canceled prior to the completion of the project and the Contractor does not furnish a new certificate of insurance prior to the cancellation, the CVPCSD may obtain the required insurance and deduct the premium(s) From contract monies due the contractor.

If such insurance is underwritten by any agency other than State Compensation Fund, such agency shall be a company authorized to do business in the State of California.

The Contractor shall require all subcontractors to maintain adequate Worker's Compensation Insurance. Certificates of such Worker's Compensation Insurance shall be filed forthwith with the Owner upon demand.

Public Liability & Property Damage

The Contractor shall furnish to the CVPCSD a certificate issued by his insurance company stating that he has minimum coverage of the following amounts: Public Liability Insurance commonly defined as Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) per person, and One million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence and Property Damage Insurance of Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) per occurrence, except as set forth in the Special Provisions, or approved by the Board of Directors. Said certificate shall be in form acceptable to the CVPCSD, and shall provide that the CVPCSD, its officers, agents and employees are additional insured under said policy.

The policy may not be canceled or reduced in coverage until after thirty (30) days written notice to and subsequent approval by the Board of Directors, and wording to this effect shall appear on the face of said certificate.

In the event the policy is canceled prior to the completion of the project and the Contractor does not furnish a new certificate of insurance prior to cancellation, the CVPCSD may obtain the required insurance and deduct the premium(s) from contract monies due the contractor.

Section 8 Prosecution and Progress shall conform to the provisions of Section 8-1.03 of the General Specifications and these Special Provisions.

8-1.03 Beginning of Work shall conform to the provisions of Section 8-1.03 of the General Specifications and these Special Provisions.

In lieu of Paragraph two of the General Specifications the following shall apply:

The Contractor will be notified by phone and/or certified mail when the contract has been fully executed and when the contract working days will commence. The counting of working days shall commence a minimum of seven (7) calendar days from such notification. The work shall be diligently prosecuted to completion before the expiration of sixty (60) working days.

8-1.07 Liquidation Damages shall conform to the provision of Section 8-1.07 of the General Specifications and these Special Provisions.

The Contractor shall pay to the CVPCSD the sum of \$100 per day, for each and every calendar day's delay in finishing the work in excess of the number of working days as prescribed in Section 8-1.103.

Section 9 Measurement and Payment shall conform to Section 9 of the General Specifications and these Special Provisions.

- 9-1.03A(1b) Labor Surcharge
The labor surcharge percentage to be applied to the actual wages paid as provided in Section 9-1.03A(1b) of the Standard Specifications will be 20 % for all work.
- 9-1.06 Partial Payment
In lieu of Paragraph One of the General Specifications the following shall apply:
The CVPCSD, on the first (1st) of each month shall cause an estimate in writing. Upon approval by the Board of Directors, payment will be made after the second Tuesday of the month or the monthly Board Meeting.
- Section 10 Dust Control shall conform to Section 10 of the General Specifications.
- Section 11 Mobilization shall conform to Section 11 of the General Specifications.
- Section 12 Construction Area Traffic Control Devices shall conform to Section 12 of the General Specifications.
- Section 13 Road Preparation shall include sweeping of all loose debris. Cracks, indentations and pot holes shall be repaired and sealed prior to paving. Roads with existing centerline stripe shall be marked with tabs to facilitate repainting. All culverts crossing roads that are to be paved shall be inspected and cleared out as necessary.
- Section 26 Chip shall conform with provisions of Section 26 of the General Specifications and these Special Provisions. Chip must be less than 20% quartz by weight and broken or crushed. The weight of the materials shall be determined as provided in Section 9-1.01, "Measurement of Quantities" of the General Specifications.

The contract price paid per ton for chip shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, material, tools, equipment, and incidentals and doing all the work involved in constructing chip.
- Section 39 Chip/Seal shall be placed at the locations shown on the plans and shall conform to the provisions of Section 39, of the General Specifications and Special Provisions.

Asphalt emulsion base stock shall be PM CRS2H @ .38gal/per square yard. The spreading vehicle must be an automatic type with a chip "belt feed" to the spreader. Chip and Seal company will provide temporary flip tab markers on existing center line prior to chip seal. Chips to be spread at a minimum of 14 lbs. per square yard, chips to be 5/16 x #8 screening. Chips to be swept within 5 days after spreading and inspected by District. Additional sweeping/cleaning up of chips to be done after 60 days as directed by the Board. CHIP/SEAL SPECIFICATIONS

The Christian Valley Park Community Service District has a total of 9+ miles of roads, 40% of the roads are asphalt and 60% are chip/seal. The District's five year program is to resurface all of the roads with chip/seal at approximately 2 miles per year

I. ASPHALT EMULSION:

- A. Base Stock to be PM CRS2H or equivalent
- B. Spreading vehicle must have computerized spreading bar.
- C. Samples may be taken at the option of CVPCSD
- D. Emulsion to meet all Caltrans Specifications or better

II. AGGREGATE:

- A. 5/16" x #8 screening
- B. Must be broken or crushed
- C. Less than 20% quartz by weight
- D. Must meet Caltrans cleanliness Specifications
- E. Must meet all other Caltrans Specifications

III. ROAD PREPARATION:

- A. Ditches and road shoulders to comply with Caltrans Specifications or better
- B. Culverts (District roads only) cleared
- C. Road surface must be prepared, cracks, indentations, pot holes, and patched as required etc.
- D. Chip/Seal to be at least the same width as existing pavement.

IV. INCIDENTALS:

- A. Contractor to hold CVPCSD harmless
- B. Name CVPCSD as additional insured on workers comp and general liability
- C. Obtain current valid copy of Contractor's License
- D. Contractor responsible for all signing, flagging and traffic control
- E. Contractor to sweep prior to seal and as necessary to jobs end
- F. Contractor will return 7 to 14 days after chip/seal for sweeping of shed chips

- G. Must be rubber tired roller
- H. Aggregate must be mechanically spread by self-propelled chip spreader
